


The second step will be to instruct students to make a photo album with 5 photographs of each of the characteristics of Cultural and Natural Heritage.






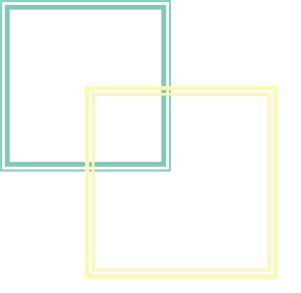
