Activity

- **Short Description:** This activity is based on the analysis of the characteristics of Creative Commons licenses to ensure the management of the subject.

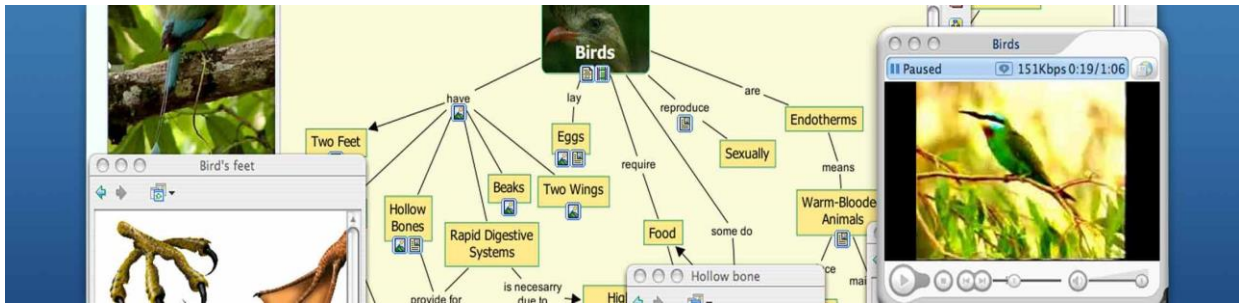

1. STEP1: Enter the creative commons [website](#) and look for the different types of licenses they offer.
2. STEP2: As soon as you have read the different licenses, you will find the similarities, differences and complexity of the licensing between them in order to make the concept map.
3. STEP 3: Go to CMap tools [website](#) and start creating your concept map.
