

Activity 1

Instructions

- 1. choose the topic you want to talk about
- 2. analyse the conflict and find out what the topic is
- 3. if you do not have enough information on the topic, deepen your search by finding more information
- 4. start inventing
- 5. identify the characters of your story
- 6. include at least one protagonist and one antagonist
- 7. if you have difficulty structuring the plot you can use the 3-act structure or "the hero's journey".
- 8. don't forget to give your characters character
- 9. Identify the characteristics of the cultural or natural good that must be transmitted
