- 6. the drawings don't have to be perfect, the important thing is that the rhythm and the framing are right
- 7. don't forget to insert the balloons with the dialogues too
- 8. Add balloons, captions and onomatopoeia in your storyboard
- 9. when you're done, have a friend read it
