Topic 1. How to start



PODCAST WILL HELP THE STUDENTS THINK ABOUT WHAT THEY WANT TO SAY AND WHY THEY WANT TO TELL IT IN A PODCAST.

BUT

STARTING FROM ONESELF, THIS EXERCISE CAN BE DONE ALONE OR IN A TEAM, ADDING A COLLECTIVE CHOICE STEP FOR THE IDEA THAT

CONVINCES THE WHOLE CLASS.

## Instructions

STEP 1 Show them the 4 circle (interests - passions - space - podcast I love) and explain to the students

that they have to write in a post-it their thoughts, as it comes to their mind without any order, without

judging, everything can be useful. And It's very important to remind that we are not searching for the "idea"

but for the center: the topic/the core that

1. STEP 2 Tell to the student to move the post-it at the center, at least one for each of the four circles

2. STEP 3 The student will explain the result of the brainstorming

3. STEP 4 (for teams only)


Every team can explain their result and the class vote for every team but not for their own. The trainer can ask like and interview, to clarify on the students-mind - this questions

> What is you podcast about?

> What is your podcast main purpose?

> Why I should listen you podcast?

> To whom your podcast is addressed?
