Lesson 1. Topic 6: Collaborate with others

Participation in a team

A team is "A group of people with a full set of complementary skills required to complete a task, job, or project. Team members (1) operate with a high degree of interdependence, (2) share authority and responsibility for self-management, (3) are accountable for the collective performance, and (4) work toward a common goal and shared rewards(s). A team becomes more than just a collection of people when a strong sense of mutual commitment creates synergy, thus generating performance greater than the sum of the performance of its individual members." (source: Business Dictionary)

- <u>Greater commitment.</u> Participating in the analysis and decision-making commits to the team's goals and organisational objectives.

- <u>More ideas.</u> The synergistic effect that occurs when people work together results in the production of a greater number of ideas, than when a person works alone.
- <u>Greater flexibility</u>. Teamwork can help companies or classrooms to be more flexible. By linking employees or students from different parts of a project to a team, problems or difficulties can sometimes be corrected more easily.
- <u>Greater innovation.</u> Use team participation can help to create a group environment that excels in creativity.
- More creativity. Creativity is stimulated by the combination of the efforts of individuals. This helps to generate new paths for thinking and reflecting on problems, processes and systems.





- <u>Improves communication.</u> Share ideas and points of view with others, in an environment that encourages open and positive communication; contributing to improve the functioning of the organisation.
- <u>Best results.</u> When people work as a team, it is indisputable that the results are improved.
