
# **IMAGE SERIES EDITING**






# Module II







#### Activity

- **Short Description**: In this activity, students will edit photos of a cultural or natural heritage element and generate a series that can be exported to an audiovisual project. They will have to look at all the pictures taken of the cultural/natural element selected, and edit the pictures chosen that portray the image we want to project. In this way, students will create a series of photographs.
- Methodology: Inductive learning.

#### Description


