







Module II







Activity

- Short Description: Find three documentary programs on natural heritage, material cultural heritage and intangible cultural heritage and analyze the chosen music. The objective is search, listen, and imitate the musical typologies applied to the different audiovisual documentary projects.
- Methodology: Research-based learning.
- **Duration:** 2 hours
- Difficulty (high medium low): Low
- Individual / Team: Individual, but group discussion.
- Classroom / House: House, but classroom discussion.

Description

• **Text description:** There is a great variety of documentaries on heritage, depending on the type of heritage element: natural, material cultural or intangible cultural. The music associated with the different types will help to correctly transmit the message, so we must know how to identify how it has been done in professional videos.







Instructions

- 2. Identify the patrimonial typology and listen to the music of the video
- 3. Establish a series of relationships between heritage and music.
