




Activity

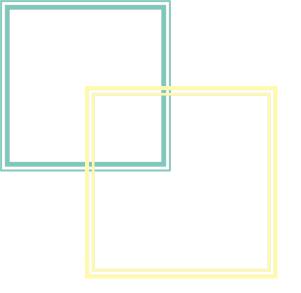
