




Course Photo-video concept Topic 2 Sound and Script



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## Activity

- **Short Description**: In this activity, students will write a short script, read it aloud so it can be recorded and then look for music that complements it. They should work with the programs that we recommend that are freely distributed.
- Methodology: Inductive learning.
- Duration: 4 hours

## Description

• **Text description:** The choice of the patrimonial element, the writing of its characteristics, the reading, the recording of the speech, the choice of music and the evaluation of the whole set playing at the same time will be an experience that will allow us to improve in each of the parts that are requested in this activity.

## Instructions

- 1. Choose a heritage item and write a short review.
- 2. Read it out loud and record that voiceover.
- 3. Choose an audio track that can accompany that script recording.

## **Expected outcomes**

- Learn about recording techniques and include the latest applications that allow us to improve our project.
- Learn to listen and define the version that has the best audio quality.
- Listen for the first time all the elements together to evaluate if the transmission of the information is correct.
