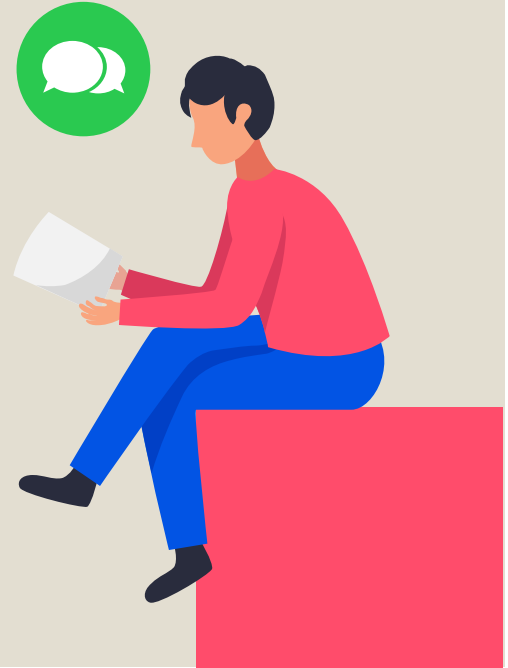

Cultural Heritage is the set of tangible and intangible elements that constitute the heritage of a human group, which emotionally reinforce its sense of community with its own identity and are perceived by others as characteristic.

“Cultural Heritage as a product of human creativity, is inherited, transmitted, modified and optimized from individual to individual and from generation to generation.” – Mayerlin Barrezueta
