To conclude...

Critical thinking gives you the ability to take decisions and solve problems.

We can divide the problem-solving process into three stages:

- Preparation or familiarization with the problem (problem statement)
- Production (come out with a recommendation)
- Judgment and evaluation (analyze consequences)



You can teach how to think critically by teaching the tools, creating opportunities to practice, coaching students in their learning process, and creating the spaces to apply systematically these methods.
