






### Storyboarding


The goal of the storyboard is to gather initial ideas for the presentation of the topic and sketch an actual storyboard showing how the comics should follow and how the topic will be presented.





- <u>Methodology</u>: Ideation process for a story.
- Duration: 2-3 hours
- <u>Difficulty</u> (high medium low): Medium low
- Individual / Team: Teams 2-3 students
- <u>Classroom / House</u>: Classroom

### Storyboarding



The goal of the storyboard is to gather initial ideas for the presentation of the topic and sketch an actual storyboard showing how the comics should follow and how the topic will be presented.

One of the options is to use blank paper and put sticky notes on it.

Another, more common option in generating video presentation storyboards is to use a storyboard template.



### STORYBOARDING SHOULD FOLLOW CERTAIN STEPS TO MAP YOUR STORY:

STEP 1 - Establish a timeline with the order of events.

STEP 2 - Identify key scenes.

STEP 3 - Decide about the details.

STEP 4 - Write the title of each cell on the storyboard.

STEP 5 - Design scenes by hand.

STEP 6 - Describe details of the scenes below the cell.

STEP 7 - Add important information

STEP 8 - Finalize the storyboard with your colleague.
